

## Comparison between Klipfolio and Zoho Analytics

Klipfolio is an online dashboard platform for building real-time business dashboards. Where as, Zoho Analytics is a full-fledged cloud BI and analytics platform. Dashboards are just one part of what you can do with Zoho Analytics. In addition to cool looking dashboards, you get a variety of visualization options (wide variety of charts, pivot views, tabular views, and summary views), formulas for custom metrics, data blending (cross analyze data from multiple sources) etc. Customera can create an unlimited number of charts, pivot tables, and summs.

With Zoho Analytics, you can slice and dice collected data, which can go back to any number of months or years. Zoho Analytics scales well and can analyze hundreds of millions of rows (terabytes of data).
